The Choral Department receives limited funding from Wake County, thus the majority of the funds to keep the department running comes from the Choral Boosters. Every family is encouraged to support their student's choir department.

Tax Deductible Sponsorship Levels:

Director: \$450 and above

- General Fund Donation - Consider making a general fund donation payment that will support the Choral program at Sanderson.

This scholarship is application based, and the student must be planning to further his/her education, in any subject (not limited to music) at any accredited university, college, junior or community college, or technical/trade institute upon graduation from high school.

FAIR SHARE

The Choral program has a **FAIR SHARE** support program to help fund the operating budget. A financial commitment exists for choral students in the amount of **\$110 for all students**. Student's FAIR SHARE can be paid via cash/check (made out to SHS Choral Boosters), or by finding community sponsors (fundraising) and that financial assistance exists in cases of need. Deadline to ask for assistance or a payment option is October 1. **Total amount of Fair Share is due by Friday, November 22.**
